QUALIFYING PLACES: Boys - 78 players will be competing for four (4) qualifying and two (2) alternate places. Girls - 26 players will be competing for two (2) qualifying and two (2) alternate places. A tie for the last qualifier's place, or an alternate's place will be decided immediately by a hole-by- hole play-off. Link here to access the fields: Boys; Girls

PRACTICE ROUNDS: To make arrangements for a practice round, players must contact the Golf Shop at (402) $498-8989$. Practice round rate is $\$ 50$ green fee and $\$ 25$ for cart. Must be 16 years old to drive a cart. Practice rounds will be available May 1-May 29 at a time convenient to the club. No practice rounds available before 2 p.m. on weekends. You may add one (1) guest to your tee time. Guest fee is $\$ 100+\$ 25$ cart fee. One practice round per player allowed and cannot be reserved more than 4 days in advance. Proper dress code is required.

CADDIES: A player may provide their own caddie. As a reminder, a player must not use a parent, step parent, or guardian as a caddie during Qualifying or Championship. If you wish to have the host club furnish a caddie, please ask the Official in Charge (listed above) because caddies may not be available through the host club.

REGISTRATION: On the qualifying day, players are requested to check in upon arrival at the registration table located just outside the golf shop. Registration will open at 6:30 a.m. for boys and 11:30 a.m. for girls.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are permitted and encouraged. Per USGA guidelines, the use of spectator carts is prohibited.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: On the qualifying day, food and beverage service will be available at the snack bar beginning at 7 a.m. Table and chairs for eating will be in the women's card room located off the golf shop. Coolers will be located on the golf-course with bottled water for players and caddies. Cash is not accepted, only credit/debit cards.

PLAY-OFF: In the event of a tie for the last qualifying place or the two alternate positions, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff to determine place winners immediately following qualifying.
LOWEST SCORE: A silver medal will be awarded to the lowest scorer. If a tie, duplicate medals will be awarded.

ELECTRONIC SCORING: To assist with real-time scoring we ask that one individual (player/caddie) in each group enter player's scores after each hole. Link here to access information on downloading the Golf Genius App for score entry.

DRESS CODE: $\quad$ Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming.

FOOTWEAR: A player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal will come in contact with the course.
DRIVERS/GOLF BALLS: The Local Rule for Conforming Driver Heads is in effect (Model Local Rule G-1). The Local Rule requiring that all golf balls used be on the List of Conforming Golf Balls is in effect, (Model Local Rule G-3). Please check the USGA web site for a list of approved golf balls and drivers. The "One Ball Rule" is not in effect (Model Local Rule G-4).
GROOVE STANDARDS: It is a requirement that a player's clubs conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Equipment Rules (Model Local Rule G-2). An Equipment Database is found on the USGA web site.
RANGEFINDERS: During qualifying rounds, the use of electronic distance measuring devices, to measure distance only, is allowed (subject to certain requirements).
CARTS: Players and caddies must not ride on any form of transportation during the qualifying round unless authorized by the Rules Committee. Spectator Carts are prohibited.
LOCAL RULES: A pair of rules documents pertinent to this qualifier are available for review prior to this competition. Link here to access the USGA's Local Rules \& Terms of the Competition and the Notice to Players (specific to qualifying at Champions Run).

PACE OF PLAY: Participants must play without undue delay and in accordance with pace of play guidelines established by the NGA attached here (boys policy and girls policy).
EVACUATION PLAN: In the event of a discontinuance of play during the qualifier, players must adhere to the evacuation plan attached here.
