# Nebraska Golf Association Junior Point Evaluation System

To be used in determining exemptions and selecting the Nebraska Junior Cup Team, NebGolf Junior All-Star Team, and the Nebraska Junior Amateur Golfer of the Year.

#### Part One - Written Portion

The purpose of the Nebraska Golf Association (NebGolf) junior point evaluation system is to establish objective criteria by which the NebGolf Junior Committee can judge the performance of junior golfers who participate in state and/or national tournaments concluding prior **to October 1**. Events concluding October 1 or later, including the NJG Fall Junior Series, will be rolled over into the following year.

#### **Tournament Participation Limit**

In order to prevent unfair advantages of one player over others, simply by playing in more tournaments, each player will only be allocated points based on his best six tournament finishes.

Tournaments included in the NebGolf Junior Point Evaluation are limited to those events listed on pages 2, 3 & 4. Each is pre-assigned a point level. In addition, those events listed on Page 5 of the NebGolf's Men's Point Evaluation System will also be included. A junior who competes in those competitions will receive the full points earned based on the chart on that page (excluding the U.S. Open and U.S. Amateur, which have point tables here on Page 3). If a player competes in a national event not included on any of those pages, the player may submit a written request (send to <a href="mailto:bvigil@nebgolf.org">bvigil@nebgolf.org</a>) for the NebGolf Junior Committee to review the event and potentially award points in an equitable manner.

#### **Nebraska Junior Cup Team**

The selection of the annual 8-man Nebraska Junior Cup Team will be based upon the NebGolf Junior Point Standings published July 18. Those golfers ranked in the top six will automatically qualify for the team. The Nebraska Golf Association Board of Directors has granted the NebGolf Junior Committee the right to select the remainder of the team, including replacements for qualifiers.

#### **NebGolf Junior All-Star Team and Junior Player of the Year Awards**

The selection of the five boys to the annual NebGolf Junior All-Star Team and Nebraska Junior Golfer of the Year award will be based upon NebGolf Junior Point Standings published October 1. The player must play in a NebGolf championship or USGA Qualifier/Championship to be eligible for these postseason awards.

NOTES: For tournaments including a cut, either for additional rounds of stroke play or to a match play bracket, only players making the cut are eligible for points. For tournaments with multiple age divisions, points are awarded only to the oldest age division, unless other divisions play the same yardage, in which case the results are combined.
